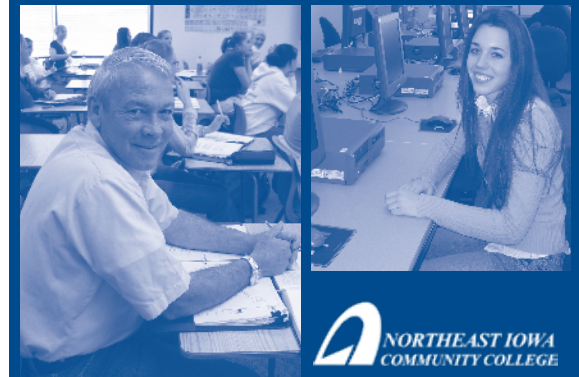

# NICC's impact in Dubuque County



## 1. High School Contracted Classes/ Postsecondary Classes

- In 2006-2007, **326** Dubuque County high school students enrolled in **2,423** credits at NICC, saving area families an estimated **\$823,522** in postsecondary tuition/college tuition.

## 2. Credit Classes

- In 2006-2007, **274** Dubuque County residents graduated from NICC, earning **289** degrees in areas such as nursing, automotive technology, associate in arts, business administration, and arboriculture.
- In 2006-2007, over **3,298** Dubuque County residents enrolled in credit classes held on the Peosta campus, or online classes originating from the Peosta campus, totaling **36,522** credits.
- In 2006-2007, **1** in **8** Dubuque County residents was served through NICC credit or continuing education classes.
- In 2006-2007, **16,718** NICC students took credit or continuing education coursework at Dubuque County locations.

## 3. Economic Impact

- **87%** of NICC graduates live, work and pay taxes in Northeast Iowa.
- NICC's impact on Northeast Iowa has grown from **\$82.4 million** to **\$235 million** in the past 5 years.

## 4. Business & Industry Training

- **5,064** new jobs were created in Dubuque County through 260E New Jobs Training Agreements which means 5,064 individuals and their families are able to live and work in the Dubuque County area. This assistance also allowed the upgrading of skills for **2,128** incumbent workers.
- **\$22.4 million** worth of training assistance has been secured by NICC for Dubuque County companies such as AY McDonald; Bodine Electric; Cottingham & Butler; Deere & Company; Heartland Financial; McKesson Corporation; Mi- T- M; Modernfold; Premier Tooling; Prudential Retirement Services; Quebecor; Sedgwick; Thermo Fisher Scientific, , and many others through the 260E New Jobs and 260F Jobs Training programs.

## 5. Continuing Education Offerings

- Over **830** continuing education classes were offered to Dubuque County residents in 2006-2007, with over **9,107** students participating.
- **3,970** Dubuque County residents enrolled in over **394** health-related training classes such as Emergency Medical and First Aid training.
