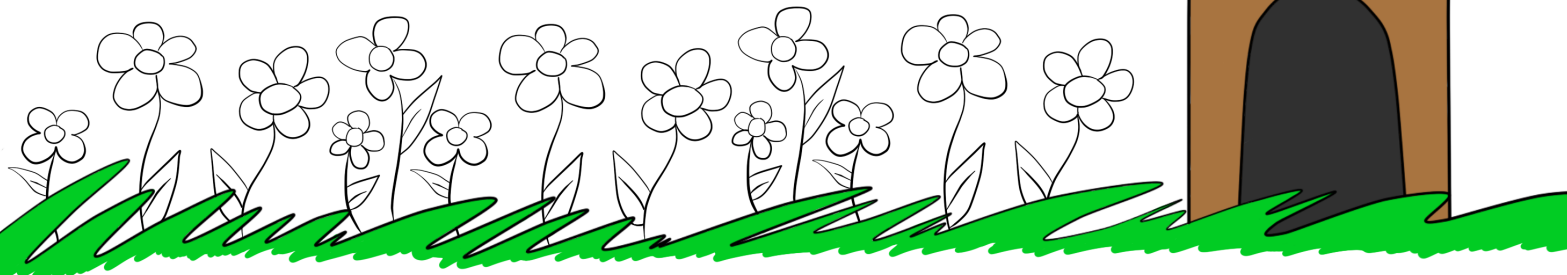
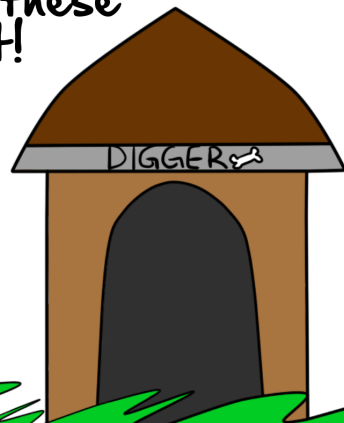

Introducing the Enbridge Energy Kids

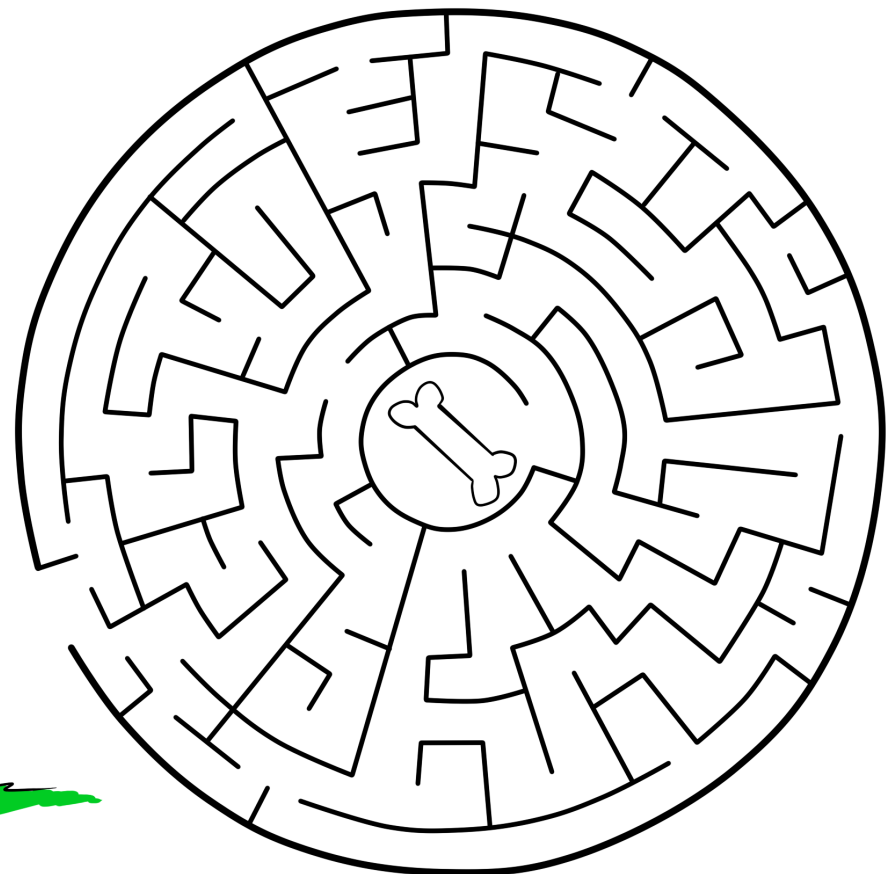
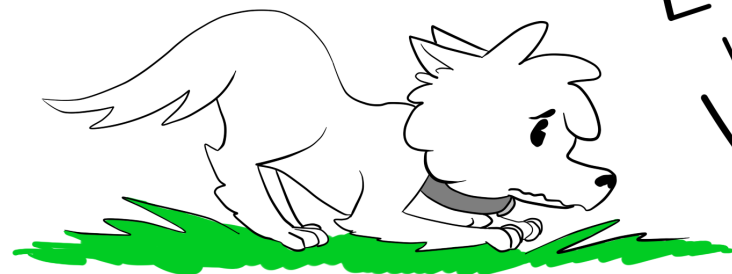
Do you know what is under the snow and grass and trees? Besides dirt and worms, there are lines called utility lines that deliver the things we use every day, such as:

- Fuel to drive our cars 

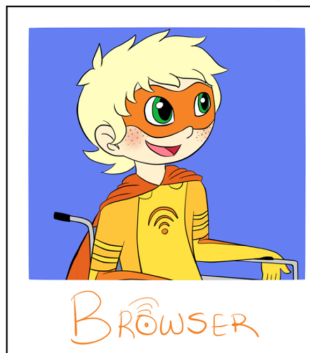
When you call 811 before you dig, someone will come and mark these lines with special colors. Each Enbridge Energy Kid is in charge of one of these special colors and will teach you about it!

We're the Enbridge Energy Kids! Draw a line to our matching flags, and write the color's name next to it!



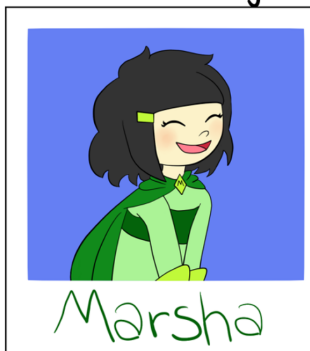
I'm Browser! I mark communication lines with orange!
