The theme, **"Shift Farm Safety Into High Gear,"** is one that resonates and reminds us that it is everyone's responsibility to prioritize safety on the farm and the rural roadways of America.

Since 1944, the third week of September has been recognized as National Farm Safety & Health Week. This week has been proclaimed by each sitting U.S. President since Franklin D. Roosevelt signed the first document.

- ▶ Tuesday, Sept. 17, 2019: Farmer Health & Opioid/Suicide Prevention
- ▶ Wednesday, Sept. 18, 2019: Safety & Health for Youth in Agriculture
- ▶ Thursday, Sept. 19, 2019: Confined Spaces in Agriculture
- ▶ Friday, Sept. 20, 2019: Safety & Health for Women in Agriculture
